TARPY'S GOAL pressed the pace off the rail, took over nearing the quarter pole then drew clear in the drive under pressure. DREAM MAESTRO stalked the pace saving ground, angled out for the drive to be up for the place. PRADO DASH in good position, steadied between horses entering the turn, found a seam in the drive but gave way. HOLDIN BULLETS set the pace to nearing the quarter pole saving ground and weakened in the stretch run. JERSEY BLUE GIANT tracked the speed three wide then faded in the drive. BELIEF SYSTEM was well placed racing four wide and tired.
