Footnotes

STAY FOREVER unhurried after bumping with JENNASIETTA at the start, raced three wide on the far turn, angled to the outside for the stretch run and rallied under pressure to be up late. CELLARS SHIRAZ stalked the pace three wide, moved to take over at the quarter pole and opened a clear lead but couldn't hold off the winner in the closing strides. MALIZIOSA well placed while saving ground, eased out for the stretch run, then split rivals to be up for the show. LIBRETTO unhurried early, advanced into contention five wide around the far turn and closed with a mild late response. LUSH SOLDIER outrun after being steadied at the start, advanced along the hedge to reach contention in the stretch, then finished evenly. JENNASIETTA trailed after bumping with STAY FOREVER at the start, then gained some ground between rivals in the drive without threatening. ELAINE'S ANGEL failed to menace. SERENE IN SEATTLE rated in striking position off the pace after breaking awkwardly, tired in the drive. COMPANY B was not a factor. BAY STREET GAL set the pace along the hedge responded when headed by LIL SISTER STICH, continued on well into the stretch and gave way. LIL SISTER STICH steadied leaving the chute, prompted the pace outside BAY STREET GAL, moved to gain a slim lead entering the far turn, then faded in the drive. TOP OF OUR GAME tracked

the pace four wide into the far turn and faltered.
