FEISTY WOMAN well placed while saving ground, eased out in the stretch, rallied to take over late and just lasted over CRIMINOLOGIST. The latter, rated off the pace, angled to the outside for the stretch run and rallied to just miss. ACQUILEIA set the pace along the rail but couldn't hold off the top ones in the closing yards. OPTIMIST GIRL (ARG) reserved early, advanced along the rail to reach contention in the stretch and flattened out. QUADERNA chased the pace into the stretch and gave way. BRUSHED BAYOU chased the pace, made a run at the leader on the far turn, then tired. POSSIBLE MAMBO steadied in the early going and was never a threat. RAIN SHOWER was not a factor. JOSIE MARCUS chased the leaders three wide into the far turn and faded.
