Footnotes

BEWARE AVALANCHE chased the pace after being outrun for the lead, rallied to take over in early stretch and drew clear under urging. BEST OF THE REST checked when caught in tight at the start, saved ground while advancing around the turn, angled out and rallied to prove second best. POWERFUL GOER outrun early, swung wide for the stretch run and closed to be up for the show. HE BE IRISH well placed in behind the leaders, tired in the drive. LIMESTONE raced in striking position three wide around the turn and lacked a late response. SLEIGHT was never a factor. JAB outran BEWARE AVALANCHE to get the lead, angled over to make the pace along the inside into the stretch and faltered. HARLAN TRAVELER was outrun. VALIANT STYLE showed early foot and faded.
