ALMUSAFSA stalked the pace along the rail, eased outside QUICK SILVER SONG in the stretch, rallied to gain the lead inside the eighth pole and drew clear. SWEET AND LOVELY rated off the pace, angled out for the stretch run and rallied to be up for the place while unable to get to the winner. HOLIDAY BROAD tracked the pace, made a run to loom a threat in midstretch but couldn't sustain her bid and was edged for the place. QUICK SILVER SONG set the pace along the rail to past the eighth pole, then gave way. SANDY KEY GAL showed brief speed, was rank when eased back off QUICK SILVER SONG, stalked that rival into the stretch and tired. ST PANCRAS reserved racing along the rail, checked from tight quarters on the far turn and failed to recover. TAXI DANCER was not a factor.
