**Footnotes**

HOLIDAY STAR broke well and settled in along the rail in opening stages, saved ground along the rail in the far turn, angled out at the top of the lane, edged up to the lead, dug in between rivals and outfinished rivals in late strides. BOLD DANCE took the lead going into the first turn, continued to set the pace by a slight margin in the backstretch, was challenged by rival nearing the quarter pole, vied along the inside of BOLD CHALLENGER into the lane, continued to vie with rivals in final strides and was outfinished at the wire. SQUALL KING was unhurried in opening stages and settled in the back of the pack, steadily began to pick up the pace, shifted out five wide in the far turn, edged up to the lead in the deep stretch but lacked a final kick to prevail. BOLD CHALLENGER stalked the pace in early stages, made a bid and edged up to the lead in the far turn, vied with BOLD DANCE into the stretch, could not keep up the pace in the late drive and weakened. THUNDER CALLS raced three wide going into the first turn, settled in along the outside of a rival and stalked the pace, urged for response nearing the far turn and finished evenly in the stretch. FIFTH AVE FANCY raced just off the leader in opening stages, continued to press the pace in the middle of the backstretch, began to weaken heading for home and had nothing left in the drive.
