TIME FOR HALO dropped out of it in the early stages, raced far back for three furlongs, rapidly closed the gap on the turn, circled five wide into the stretch then closed strongly in the middle of the track to get up in the final twenty yards. VAL'S JAZZ was unhurried early after breaking a bit slowly, rallied four wide to reach contention entering the stretch, made a run to challenge in deep stretch but was outfinished by the winner. MISS PLACED was reserved for five furlongs while saving ground, checked along the inside while rallying in midstretch then finished well between horses when clear in the final sixteenth. WILD FASHION chased the pacesetter from outside to the turn, surged to the front in midstretch then weakened in the final eighth. WINI JONES sprinted clear in the early stages, set a rapid pace into upper stretch and tired from her early efforts. SPECTACULAR SYD raced just off the pace between horses along the backstretch, saved ground on the turn and tired. ONE STEP FORWARD showed only brief speed. STRUMMING chased three wide to the turn and gave way.
