YONAGUSKA chased the pace three wide down the backstretch, moved to take over nearing the quarter pole and drew well clear, then was all out to hold off CITY ZIP. The latter, reserved off the pace, angled four wide entering the stretch and was gaining quickly on the winner at the finish. SPARKLING SABRE well placed while racing three wide around the turn, outfinished the others for the show. TRU BULL showed speed along the rail, continued on well into the stretch and gave way. DIABLO'S CHOICE showed speed between TRU BULL and YONAGUSKA to the turn, then tired. FRIDAY'S A COMIN' steadied in the early going and lacked a rally. DARING PEGASUS off slowly, advanced into contention entering the stretch but had no late response. ALASKAN STAR faltered while saving ground. ICANSEETHERAIN raced three wide on the turn and faded. ROYAL FUTURE steadied when he swerved at the gap leaving the chute, was rank under restraint racing down the backstretch and outrun. MONSIEUR CAT bobbled at the start, raced four wide around the turn and was never close.
