SHAKESPEARESTISTER (GB) rated off the pace, advanced into contention three wide on the far turn, angled in to split rivals and gain the lead at the eighth pole, then drew clear under urging. PEPPERMINT LILLY up close early, eased back on the first turn, raced four wide around the far turn, rallied along the outside to reach even terms for command in the stretch but couldn't match strides with the winner while holding the place. GINGERBREAD MISS steadied in the early going and again on the first turn, stalked the pace along the inside into the stretch, eased out and closed to gain the show while unable to stay with the top ones. HOLDEN CHAMPAGNE unhurried early, circled rivals four wide to gain a slim lead on the far turn, then weakened in the drive. DANCE OF JOY allowed to settle, raced four wide on the far turn and passed tired rivals. MILLE LACS tracked the pace, then was checked in behind rivals entering the far turn and failed to recover. BEST ONE chased the pace three wide, made a run to reach even terms for command on the far turn, then tired in the drive. PAMMIE FROM MIAMI was never a factor after hesitating at the start. SPEEDY MUSIC chased the pace, made a run at the lead on the far turn, then faltered. FLYING FINISH set the pace along the rail into the far turn, then faded. MISS AUDREY clipped heels soon after the start and unseated her rider. There was a stewards inquiry into the fallen rider.
