Footnotes

SINGING ROCK tracked the pace, angled outside the leaders for the drive, rallied to take over at the eighth pole and drew clear under urging. KHRUSHCHEV rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn, swung out even wider for the stretch run and closed to be up for the place while unable to gain on the winner. CENZONTLE chased the pace, eased out and made a run between horses to reach near even terms for command in the stretch but was outfinished. SILK TRIPPI stalked the pace three wide, made a run outside CENZONTLE to reach even terms for command nearing the eighth pole, then gave way. MILLENNIUM JET allowed to settle, improved his position along the inside in the drive. MIA CONCERTO raced three wide around the far

turn and failed to menace. MADMAN was not a factor. MOVE THE CAT off slowly, saved ground and tired. OUR SUN vied for the lead along the rail to nearing the eighth pole, then faltered. MONTFORT vied for the lead outside OUR SUN to nearing the eighth pole, then faded. COMPRISE unhurried while saving ground, was attempting to rally into contention when steadied to avoid running up on a rival at the sixteenth pole and failed to recover. THIS CAT'S UNREAL trailed after breaking slowly.
