Footnotes

KERI KERI was allowed to settle in along the inside in early stages, angled out slightly and steadily began to pick up the pace, shifted out four wide in the far turn, edged up to leaders at the top of the lane, took command midstretch and continued clear under steady urging to the wire. ENGLISH CROSSING was unhurried early and settled in near the back of rivals, asked to pick up the pace heading near the far turn, raced four wide at the top of the lane, gained

position five wide in the stretch, could not catch KERI KERI and settled for second best. VERY PLAYFUL was well reserved in early stages and raced near the back of rivals, was carried out by rival in the far turn, quickly gained ground in the stretch but was too late to make an impact. CONQUESTA pressed the pace in early stages, made bid for the leader nearing the far turn, vied with rivals in the uppers stretch, could not keep up the pace and weakened in the late drive. STARSHIP SECRET stalked the pace along the inside in the backstretch, saved ground along the rail in the far turn and finished evenly in the drive. BLUFFING QUALITY raced five wide into the first turn, settled in stalking the pace in the backstretch, raced three to four wide in the far turn and lacked a late kick to make an impact. STARSHIP MELODY raced just off the leader in opening stages, continued to press the pace in the backstretch, matched strides with rival heading into the far turn, could not keep up the pace and steadily began to weaken at the top of the lane. MORE THAN SPEED took command by a slight margin in early stages, matched strides with rival going into the far turn, could not keep up the pace and weakened in the uppers stretch. SOMETHING CASUAL lacked speed in early stages, continued reserved near the back of rivals and failed to rally in the stretch. MARY COLE tracked the pace in early stages, drifted out in the far turn and lacked response in the drive. FLO'S A GO was reserved in early stages and raced near the back of the pack, continued evenly and failed to make a bid. COTTON KINGDOM raced four wide going into the first turn, raced evenly near the back of rivals and failed to respond in the stretch.
