**Footnotes**

DOUBLE THE ENERGY tracked the top two leaders in opening stages, advanced position leaving the backstretch, edged up to the lead at the top of the lane, vied three deep in the upper stretch, shook free midstretch and continued clear. ROSA SALVAJE took the lead at the start, continued to set the pace along the inside in the backstretch, was challenged by rivals in the far turn, vied between rivals in the upper stretch and held on to second place at the wire. WHIPSAW CITY (FR) settled in along the inside and stalked the early pace, began to pick up the pace nearing the far turn, edged up to the lead, vied along the inside of rivals in the stretch and lacked a final kick in final strides. NAKANO stalked the pace in the backstretch, angled out slightly going into the far turn, raced four wide into the lane and continued a steady even bid in the drive. SWEET AND LOWDOWN raced just off the leader in opening quarter, began to lose position heading into the far turn and came up empty in the stretch. FUNNY SUNNY raced in the back of rivals in the backstretch, continued reserved heading for home, saved ground in the far turn and failed to respond in the stretch.
