Footnotes

CONFORMAL forced the pace from outside for six furlongs, opened a clear advantage in upper stretch and drew away while being kept to the task. PRINCESS FRANNY sprinted clear along the inside on the first turn, set the pace along the rail into upper stretch but couldn't stay with the winner through the final eighth. KRIS IS IT settled just off the early pace, moved a bit closer while three wide on the turn and lacked a strong closing bid. FIRMNESS raced within striking distance between horses on the turn and lacked the needed response when called upon. DELIGHTFUL BREEZE never reached contention. BLUE RIDGE MISS raced up close while saving ground for five furlongs and tired. SING OUR SONG checked slightly at the start, raced wide and tired.
