Footnotes

SILVER CHELE was unhurried while racing behind horses to the turn, split rivals to get clear in upper stretch then closed steadily to win going away. NOTABLE CRAFT, never far back, slipped through along the rail to gain a slim lead on the turn, opened a clear advantage in upper stretch but couldn't hold the winner safe. AH CHOOTING STAR stumbled at the start gained along the inside on the far turn, awaited room while behind horses on the turn, made a run to threaten in midstretch but couldn't sustain her bid. SHESA LOOK N GOOD, reserved early, rallied four wide on the turn, was bumped a bit in upper stretch then lacked a strong closing bid. STYLISH STEPPER set the pace slightly off the rail to the turn then drifted out brushing with POPCORN ALLEY while tiring in upper stretch. GROOMANITA never reached contention. POPCORN ALLEY forced the pace from outside to the turn then steadied between horses while giving way in upper stretch. DECAPOLIS failed to mount a serious rally.
