The latter, unhurried early, circled rivals on the turn, then rallied while lugging in through the stretch to just miss. WALKINAROUND MONEY wearing a nasal strip, was well placed racing along the rail, then weakened in the drive. BOBBY'S BUCKAROO vied for the lead along the inside around the turn and tired. BOUGHT IN DIXIE off slowly, made a run at the leaders four wide on the turn, then faltered. WOULDNT WE ALL was through early. DYHIM DIAMOND (IRE) was outrun.
