Footnotes

SERAZZO stalked the pace three wide, rallied to gain a slim lead nearing the eighth pole, then dueled with TUBROK to the wire and prevailed. TUBROK rated off the pace, rallied four wide around the turn to reach even terms for command nearing the eighth pole, then dueled with SERAZZO to the wire and just missed. BAHROBA outrun early, swung wide for the stretch run and closed well for the show. CHEROKEEINTHEHILLS unhurried early, angled out for the drive and finished willingly. GATOBEANACTOR reserved after breaking awkwardly, advanced into contention down the backstretch, then steadied soon after entering the far turn and couldn't gain in the drive. THE KNIGHT SKY prompted the pace outside SAM'S CONCORDE, moved to gain a slim lead on the far turn, then gave way in the final eighth. THREE WONDERS well placed while saving ground, checked inside GATOBEANACTOR on the far turn and failed to recover. SAM'S CONCORDE set the pace along the rail into the far turn and faltered.
