Footnotes

POLO GROUNDS rated off the pace, angled out in the stretch and rallied under pressure to be just up in the final strides. NEW SCIENCE chased the pace, moved to take over on the far turn, then just failed to last. CAESARION (IRE) allowed to settle, swung wide for the stretch run and rallied to be up for the show. GO DIRECTLYTO JAIL stalked the pace along the rail, eased out and made a run to reach near even terms for command in midstretch, then gave way. ORPINGTON unhurried early, improved his position in the drive without threatening. ECCLESIASTIC tracked the pace three wide, was steadied in behind NEW SCIENCE in early stretch, made a run to loom a threat in midstretch, then weakened. BON FLEUR reserved racing along the inside, eased out and split rivals to reach the leaders inside the eighth pole, then tired. LONG POND stalked the pace, made a run to join the leaders in midstretch, then faltered. THE PENNY DROPS was outrun. SABRE BABY off slowly, was never a factor. AMADOR well placed early, raced three wide on the far turn and faded. HALO GOODBYE showed speed along the rail into the far turn and stopped. (The rail on the turf course was set at 84 feet).
