ALMORADI (IRE) rank under restraint while saving ground, eased out for the stretch run, rallied to gain the lead nearing the eighth pole, then was all out to just last over SHOW THE WAY J. The latter, unhurried after breaking slowly, saved ground while advancing around the far turn, angled outside the leaders and rallied to just miss. TOM KITTEN rated off the pace, advanced three wide around the far turn to loom a threat in the stretch, then weakened. WILD ENTRY (JPN) reserved off the pace, advanced to loom a threat in the stretch but had no further response. LIVE ON THE EDGE allowed to settle, swung out for the stretch run and passed tired rivals. SUNSHINE RAMBLER raced in striking position into the far turn and tired. THE GREAT MCGEE moved through

inside SHIMMERING FOREST to take over on the first turn, made the pace along the rail into the stretch, then faltered. COLONEL POTTER saved ground to no avail. SHIMMERING FOREST set the early pace, chased THE GREAT MCGHEE into the far turn after losing the lead, then faded. MR. RICO was through early. VINI VIDI VINCI was outrun after hesitating at the start. ROMANS REWARD showed little.
