AQSAAM set the pace racing well off the rail, responded when MILLENNIA moved to the fore entering the stretch the final time, then came on again under pressure to be up late. MILLENNIA stalked the pace along the inside, moved to take over from AQSAAM leaving the final turn but couldn't resist the winner late. MUSICAL RAIN (IRE) stalked the pace off the rail into the stretch but couldn't gain late. WOODFORD BELLE stalked the pace, advanced around the final turn to reach contention but had no further response. HAPPY CLAPPER rated off the pace, raced three wide and failed to menace. DANCING RAGE was not a factor. TWO WONDERS reserved off the pace, faltered.
