MODEST set the pace along the inside, came out a bit for the stretch run, then was all out to hold off HARDROCKER. The latter, reserved off the pace while saving ground, rallied along the rail to just miss. MOONSTOCK rated off the pace, advanced four wide around the far turn to loom a threat in midstretch, then flattened out. WIN EXCHANGE chased the winner into the stretch and weakened. EMPIRICIST stalked the pace three wide to the top of the stretch, then gave way. WHERE'S THE BABY unhurried early, circled rivals five wide around the far turn to reach contention but didn't do enough late. LOVE OF FLYING failed to menace. ECLIPTICALSPRALINE well placed into the stretch, had no response when asked. BLUEGRASS SUMMER was no factor while saving ground.
