Footnotes

INGENUITY was urged to gain the advantage in the opening stages remaining well off the rail racing through the backstretch, extended the advantage racing into the bend and dictated terms on a commanding margin to the end under steady encouragement. SUCCESSFUL BROTHERS was rated tracking off the second flight in early stages, was prompted to advance four wide racing through the turn to upper stretch and proved best of the others while failing to menace the winner. RAGING MANE was guided to the rail early while dropping well off the second flight, saved ground to upper stretch steadily gaining position inside foes but had no final kick. THE BEST MONKEY was settled off the second flight early and continued evenly between foes to late stages. JIM JAMM was rated off the second flight while angling inwards in the opening half, was prompted to lodge a brief bid between foes racing through the turn but emptied out in the drive. CHEVRON LIGHT was settled out of striking distance four wide between foes on the backstretch and never menaced thereafter. NOBLE ABODE, urged to gain a forward placing three deep tracking just off the pacesetter racing through the backstretch, emptied out racing through the turn. WAKE UP AND GO, reserved between foes in early stages, never seriously menaced. BYTHE GRACE OF GOD swerved in sharply at the start losing position to the field and never menaced thereafter. DARDANIAN, caught five deep in the last flight early, proved no threat. TO DARE IS TO DO, urged along prompting the pacesetter between rivals in the opening stages, couldn't sustain that pace racing into the bend, was soon outdistanced, then pulled up racing

into the stretch but walked off the course under his own power.
