MISS INQUISTIVE dueled for the lead along the rail, edged clear in midstretch and was all out to hold off SWEPT AWAY to prevail. The latter, dueled for the lead, was outmoved in midstretch, then continued on gamely while unable to wear down the winner. REGALLY APPEALING chased the pace three wide into the stretch and weakened. COOLBYTHEPOOL unhurried early, improved her position while drifting out under pressure. SAHARA GOLD saved ground while advancing into contention in the stretch, then tired. SABRE DANCE was no factor after being outrun early. SHAWNEE COUNTRY chased the pace four wide around the turn and faltered. SINCERELY was through early. BACKATEM raced four wide on the turn and faded.
