CAPT. CANDYMAN CAN showed speed, eased back off the leaders on the backstretch, angled four wide on the turn, rallied to gain the lead at the top of the stretch and was fully extended to prevail. HELLO BROADWAY away alertly, set the pace under pressure inside ROCKETING RETURNS, responded when headed by CAPT. CANDYMAN CAN at the top of the stretch but couldn't stay with that rival in the final eighth while clearly second best. BEE CEE CEE rated off the pace after hitting the gate at the start, raced three wide around the turn and closed to be up for the show. SALO JAK failed to menace. ROCKETING RETURNS pressed the pace outside HELLO BROADWAY to nearing the stretch, then tired. BREAK WATER EDISON reserved off the pace, raced four wide around the turn and faltered.
