 THIS ONES FOR PHIL chased the pace in hand, moved up to engage PASHITO THE CHE racing into the stretch, then dueled with and just edged that rival to the wire. PASHITO THE CHE showed speed off the rail, responded when challenged by THIS ONES FOR PHIL leaving the turn, then dueled with that rival and just failed in a game effort. DRIFT KING chased the pace three wide around the turn and tired. ACCREDIT was not a factor. SNEAKING UPONYOU stumbled at the start, chased the pace along the inside into the turn, then faltered. MACHISMO off slowly, raced in contention four wide to the turn, then faded. ROCKERFELLER trailed.
