**Footnotes**

SWEET REPENT taken in hand to stalk the pace off the rail, eased outside the leaders for the drive, rallied to gain the lead just inside the eighth pole, then drew away under urging. JESSICA IS BACK broke open the gate prior to the start, vied for the lead outside AMAZING, edged away from that rival on the backstretch, responded when that rival came to her again, contested the pace to the eighth pole, then was no match for the winner while continuing on with good courage for the place. EVEN ROAD unhurried after being steadied in behind CAT CAN DO on the first turn, passed tired rivals to be up for the show. AMAZING vied for the lead along the rail, was outmoved by JESSICA IS BACK on the backstretch, came back on to vie with that rival again around the far turn and into the stretch, then tired. CHRISTMAS SHIP checked from tight quarters along the rail on the first turn, tracked the pace to midway of the far turn, then faltered and finished on even terms with SCOLARA. The latter, raced three wide and failed to menace while dead heating with CHRISTMAS SHIP. UNFORGOTTEN was not a factor. CAT CAN DO was outrun after clipping heels with GRANTED TIGER on the first turn. GRANTED TIGER rated off the pace after being steadied from tight quarters entering the first turn, faded leaving the far turn.
