## Footnotes

BA BA'S BUNCH set the pace along the rail, repulsed a bid from THE WEST RIM on the far turn and reopened a clear lead, then was all out to last over DISTORTED LEGACY. The latter, outrun early, swung out for the stretch run and rallied to just miss catching the winner. I DREAMT I WAS off slowly, saved ground, advanced into contention around the far turn, eased out in the stretch and was gaining on the winner at the finish. THE WEST RIM stalked the pace, made a run to try BA BA'S BUNCH racing into the far turn but was outfinished. LA REINE LIONNE rank and steadied in behind the leader around the first turn, stalked the pace along the inside, angled out for room bumping with PERFECT EMBRACE at the top of the stretch, then gained some ground without threatening. PERFECT EMBRACE stalked the pace three wide, then bumped with LA REINE LIONNE at the top of the stretch and gave way. LAKESIDE CHAPEL off slowly, failed to menace. PERFORMING rated off the pace, made a run five wide on the far turn to reach contention, then tired. ON MY WAY tracked the pace four wide to midway of the far turn, then faltered. QUEEN HAZEL was done early.
