BET ME BEST forced the pace outside TEXAS GLITTER, drew even entering the stretch, then edged TEXAS GLITTER in a long drive while bumping with that rival approaching the finish. TEXAS GLITTER moved up quickly to set the pace racing just off the rail, responded gamely when challenged and just missed while bumping with BET ME BEST nearing the wire. CAT THIEF, outrun early, advanced three wide around the turn, then rallied mildly in the drive to best the others. SAN GENNARO allowed to settle, swung out for the stretch run and passed tired rivals while never a threat. SEPTEMBER DESERT was used chasing the pace. DARLEY MAN was no factor. SILK BROKER well placed early, faltered.
