EVVY under stout restraint early, came through along the inside into the stretch, angled outside the leaders and rallied to be just up at the wire. GO WENT GONE reserved off the pace while saving ground, rallied along the rail to just miss while getting up for the place. SWEET SCARLET slipped through along the rail on the backstretch to vie for the lead, came off the rail for the drive and gave way grudgingly. PEER REVIEW outrun early, swung out for the stretch run closed some ground. MAJESTIC MOOD rated off the pace, made a run four wide on the far turn to loom a threat in midstretch, then flattened out. PRIMAL RAGE raced with the pace three wide into the stretch and weakened. SI TIGRE LIL showed speed racing off the rail into the final turn and faltered.
