SENIOR SWINGER rated off the pace, rallied three wide on the far turn, moved to take over in the stretch, then just lasted to finish on even terms with TEN CENTS A SHINE. The latter, unhurried early, advanced three wide on the far turn, then rallied outside SENOR SWINGER to dead heat for the win. ROARING FEVER tracked the pace along the inside, then couldn't keep pace with the top ones while gaining the show. COLOR ME GONE unhurried after being steadied to avoid CHEDDAR when he broke to the inside at the start, passed tired rivals in the drive. THE NAME'S BOND set the pace along the rail into the stretch and tired. DYNASTYLE failed to menace. AWESOME TIME raced four wide on the far turn and was not a factor. GRAND LUCENCI

prompted the pace outside THE NAME'S BOND to nearing the stretch and faltered. HOT HAND was outrun after breaking in the air. AMERICAN MON showed little. CHEDDAR chased the pace three wide, faded and was eased in the final eighth.
