Footnotes

SKY LOVER stalked the pace, raced four wide around the far turn, rallied to take over in deep stretch, then just lasted over TREASURE THIEF. The latter, unhurried early, angled to the outside in the stretch and rallied to just miss. CHANNEL CHANGER set the early pace along the inside, was outmoved by

several rivals racing down the backstretch, angled out for room leaving the far turn and finished willingly for the show. STRAPPING chased the pace, moved to take over racing down the backstretch and eased to the inside, made the pace to deep stretch, then gave way. KING KHALIFA outrun after breaking slowly, advanced along the rail to loom a threat, then was steadied, angled out for room inside the eighth pole and failed to recover. SCANDALO stumbled at the start, chased the pace, moved up with STRAPPING down the backstretch to press the pace outside that rival into the stretch, then tired. INDYGO PRINCE outrun early, improved his position without threatening. DIVINE MICHAEL rated off the pace, rushed up three wide down the backstretch to join the leaders, stayed with those rivals to midway of the far turn, then faltered. MECKE MANTLE failed to menace. LOS ROMOS LOCOS was never a factor. BILLY SHIRTS raced three wide and faded. ARMOR was done early and eased in the stretch run.
