**Footnotes**

PARTY BOY rated off the pace, eased out four wide on the far turn, rallied to take over at the eighth pole, then was all out to just last over RULE NUMBER SIX. The latter, unhurried early, raced three wide around the far turn, angled out for the stretch run and rallied to just miss. SOLICITATION stalked the pace three wide around the far turn and finished willingly while being edged to the wire by the top ones. MOOR OF VENICE stalked the pace along the rail, slipped through inside TOASTMASTER to reach near even terms for command approaching the eighth pole but was outfinished. JACKWAGON allowed to settle, advanced to reach contention in the stretch but couldn't sustain his bid. REGAL PAL saved ground and failed to menace. D' NEXT EXPERIENCE chased the pace into the stretch and tired. TOASTMASTER set the pace along the inside, came out a bit for the stretch run while maintaining the advantage to nearing the eighth pole, then faltered. OH NO THE ALARM was never a factor.
