Footnotes

CHARLIE THE BOSS broke readily to gain the advantage along the inside, dictated the pace on a comfortable margin under light rating racing to the second bend, was prompted to turn back challenges from several rivals racing into upper stretch and maintained a safe margin to the end under firm encouragement. ATLANTIC SPRING was rated tracking off the second flight a bit off the inside in the opening half, was urged to split foes then shift out three deep on the far turn while being prompted to advance on the leader, continued in pursuit of that rival while shifting about under pressure racing through the stretch but couldn't gain even terms with that foe. THUNDER RUN settled outside foes tracking off the second flight in the opening half, made a steady advance to contention three deep nearing the far turn, continued with a steady bid while being fanned four wide racing into upper stretch but continued willingly in that path to the end to prevail for a share. BRACIGLIANO was guided to the inside while dropping off the second flight early, gradually drew into contention on the far turn, briefly awaited an opening nearing upper stretch, shifted out four wide racing into upper stretch, was forced to alter course avoiding some traffic midstretch but continued with an effort to gain position to the end. BROWNS GAP, urged to gain a forward placing tracking just off the pacesetter along the inside racing into the far turn, gave way racing past midstretch. DIG ALITTLE DEEPER was urged to gain a forward placing tracking just off the pacesetter three deep early, continued between foes in the second flight racing into the far turn while being prompted to lodge a brief bid but quickly came up empty. SEEKER OF TRUTH was settled three deep between foes racing to the backstretch and offered no rally. BULL MARKET

RICHIE broke in the air while shifting into the path of STRIKE 'N SPARE, was guided to the inside tracking off the second flight racing to the backstretch but lacked a rally. STRIKE 'N SPARE broke slowly, then was shuffled out of close quarters at the start and never menaced thereafter.
