Footnotes

PINBALL, urged to the fore along the inside from the break, dictated the pace on a clear margin into the backstretch, was prompted to turn back a challenger racing through the far turn, was bumped nearing midstretch by ERIUGENA (IRE), exchanged repeated contact with that rival, was roused left handed while shifting out late crossing the path of HURRICANE ELVIS nearing the wire but narrowly prevailed in a grudging effort while having his course corrected approaching the wire. HURRICANE ELVIS, bumped by FRANKLIN PARK at the start and forced into AMPERSAND, was settled into stride along the inside, steadily gathered momentum saving ground on the far turn, shifted out to split foes three deep challenging for command in late stages but couldn't gain even terms with the winner while being carried out slightly by that foe nearing the wire. TOWN EXTENSION was rated tracking just off the first flight outside those foes racing to the backstretch, was urged to challenge three deep on the far turn into upper stretch but couldn't match terms with the top pair. ERIUGENA (IRE) worked his way to the inside tracking off the second flight in early stages, steadily advanced to striking distance along the rail racing into upper stretch, was urged through close quarters to challenge inside the eventual winner midstretch bumping that foe, continued to exchange repeated contact while being steadied slightly in the closing stages and failed to sustain his momentum. AMPERSAND, bumped at the start, was reserved off the second flight racing to the backstretch, was urged to advance between foes racing into the far turn, shifted out four wide nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. TARGET SIGHTED tracked off the second flight between foes racing to the backstretch, continued three deep between foes into the far turn but offered no rally. BOLD CHALLENGER, forwardly placed stalking the pacesetter in the opening stages, was urged to prompt that foe racing into the far turn, emptied out racing into upper stretch, then altered course in traffic late. FRANKLINPARK broke inwards bumping HURRICANE ELVIS, was settled outside foes racing to the backstretch and never gained contention. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE RIDER OF ERIUGENA (IRE) LODGED A CLAIM

OF FOUL AGAINST THE WINNER ALLEGING INTERFERENCE IN MIDSTRETCH BUT THAT CLAIM WAS DISALLOWED.
