Footnotes

PROUD OF ROSIE unhurried early, advanced between horses on the far turn, was steadied in behind WALL STREET LEGEND at the eighth pole, then wore that rival down to prevail. WALL STREET LEGEND set the pace along the inside to deep stretch but couldn't resist the winner while holding the place. BRILLIANT LOVER stalked the pace along the inside, eased out in the stretch and made a run at the leader, then weakened. SUNRISE HALO tracked the pace, rallied to loom a threat in the stretch but couldn't sustain her bid. LILA'S MAGGIE MAY allowed to settle, advanced four wide on the far turn to reach contention but had no late response. AOMI steadied in traffic on the first turn, tracked the pace four wide around the far turn and tired. DANCING MILLY raced in striking position around the far turn and faltered. WAR BISCUIT failed to menace. FOR OLGA was not a factor. BACK TO REALITY was saving ground when checked in behind a rival on the far turn and never threatened. LEAHS SONG stumbled at the start, chased the pace three wide into the far turn, then faded. RAPITON up close early, was through after half mile.
