DYNANTONIA stalked the pace along the rail, rallied and slipped through inside BARON VON TAP to gain the lead inside the eighth pole, then was fully extended to prevail. BARON VON TAP set the pace along the inside, came off the rail for the drive allowing DYNANTONIA through inside him and gave way grudgingly. SALINJA rated off the pace after breaking slowly, steadied in traffic on the far turn, then finished willingly for the show. WOOD BE WILLING off slowly, was unhurried early, moved up four wide around the far turn but had no late response. PITCHNICHOLAS saved ground and failed to menace. MANCHU PRINCE prompted the pace outside BARON VON TAP into the far turn, then tired. FAMOUS FROLIC stalked the pace three wide, then was steadied from between rivals in the stretch and faltered.
