SPRING AT LAST showed speed along the rail, eased back off DAAHER leaving the first turn, continued to save ground in behind that rival into the far turn, angled out, rallied to gain the lead at the quarter pole and opened a clear lead, then was fully extended to hold off A. P. ARROW. The latter, unhurried early, angled four wide on the far turn, then closed well and was getting to the winner at the wire. KISS THE KID moved up on the backstretch to press the pace outside DAAHER, gained the lead briefly midway of the far turn, then weakened in the drive. BRASS HAT outrun after breaking slowly, closed with a belated rally to just miss the show. FAIRBANKS rated off the pace, made a run on the backstretch to reach contention racing into the far turn, then gave way. EINSTEIN (BRZ) reserved early, advanced three wide to reach contention entering the far turn, then faltered. DAAHER showed speed outside SPRING AT LAST, angled in when that rival eased back leaving the first turn, responded when engaged by KISS THE KID on the backstretch, continued to make the pace under pressure from that rival to midway of the far turn, then faltered. DR GOOGLES BOOGLES showed early foot along the inside, then was fading when steadied from close quarters on the far turn.
