SEASONAL STYLE (IRE) unhurried after hesitating at the start, advanced four wide around the far turn and rallied while drifting in to be up late. PRINCIPAL AFFAIR set the pace along the inside, responded gamely when challenged and just failed to last. GOLDEN LIVELY close up while saving ground, was attempting to split horses when forced to check in midstretch, then closed willingly when clear. HAWKAHONTAS outrun early, swung to the outside for the stretch run and closed with a belated rally. DOE RIVER steadied in the early going, then was checked when blocked in midstretch and failed to recover. HALO ESKIMO stalked the pace, made a run at the leader on the far turn, then weakened in the drive. GOLD PIECE saved ground, then was checked twice trying to get through along the rail in the stretch and failed to threaten. BAGASSE chased the pace three wide and tired. JELLY FISH was always outrun. FAR OUT SANDIE was through early.
