Footnotes

ATLAS VALLEY chased the pace four wide, moved up to vied for the lead outside SAINT KRIS on the turn, edged away from that rival nearing the sixteenth pole, then was fully extended to hold off ANNA'S BALLERINA. The latter, reserved racing along the inside, steadied on the turn, angled out for the stretch run, was steadied again to avoid running up on U. S. S. BOXER, then angled back in and rallied to just miss. R. AND R. reserved early, raced four wide on the turn and closed to be up for the show. SAINT KRIS chased the pace three wide, moved up to vie for the lead around the turn and into the stretch, then weakened in the final sixteenth. CARLSON'S QUEEN chased the leaders into the stretch and tired. QUEST TO PEAK vied for the lead along the rail to the quarter pole and gave way. U. S. S. BOXER vied for the lead outside QUEST TO PEAK, then faltered in the drive. DEJEUNER was outrun after breaking awkwardly. BYE BYGONE allowed to settle, faded in the drive. SOMETHINGTREASURED well placed after breaking slowly, was through after a half mile. I LOVE TO SAY YES was done early and eased in the stretch run.
