Footnotes

ACADIANO stalked the pace, angled outside the leaders leaving the far turn, then rallied under pressure to be just up at the wire. LIL DIAZO quickly moved to the fore, made the pace along the rail, shook off a challenge from SLEEK JOHN on the far turn and opened a clear lead in early stretch, then just failed to last. SLEEK JOHN prompted the pace outside LIL DIAZO, tried that rival around the far turn, then weakened in the drive. MYSTERY PROSPECT reserved while saving ground, angled out for the drive and closed with a mild rally. MYSTERIOUS BOY tracked the pace three wide to nearing the stretch, then tired. DANCING IN GERARDA was no factor after being outrun early. KING COUNTY broke slowly, then was steadied in the early going and again on the first turn, raced four wide around the far turn and lacked a rally. COASTAL VOW rated off the pace, rushed up three wide around the first turn to reach the leaders, raced with those rivals into the far turn, then faltered. MONEY ISSUES up close racing along the rail, was steadied in tight quarters on the first turn and was through soon after.
