HAL'S MY HOPE pressed the pace outside ROMAN'S RUN, moved to gain a slim lead entering the far turn, then was fully extended to prevail. SILVER EXPRESS stalked the pace three wide, made a run to reach the leaders entering the far turn, tried HAL'S MY HOPE through the stretch and was outgamed to the wire. HIGHEST DEGREE outrun early, swung out for the stretch run and closed well for the show. HIGH ACT bumped soundly with ROMAN'S RUN at the start, tracked the pace, eased out for the stretch run and finished willingly while just being edged for the show. ROMAN'S RUN bumped hard at the start, set the pace along the inside, responded when headed by HAL'S MY HOPE into the far turn, continued to contest the pace to deep stretch and gave way. RUTLEDGE CAT reserved along the inside, was steadied to avoid running up on SEASIDE LINKS leaving the first turn and again on the backstretch, then never threatened. TORINI rated off the pace, raced four wide on the far turn and tired. DIVINE MASTER steadied in traffic on the first turn, advanced three wide around the far turn to reach contention, then faltered in the drive. SEASIDE LINKS was steadied repeatedly in behind ROMAN'S RUN for the first half mile, saved ground into the far turn and faded.
