ADORE THE GOLD set the pace under pressure along the inside, edged away from FOREFATHERS entering the stretch, then was fully extended to prevail. FOREFATHERS pressed the pace outside ADORE THE GOLD, was outmoved by that rival racing into the stretch but continued on with good courage to prove clearly best of the rest while unable to wear down the winner. COWTOWN CAT hustled to chase the leaders three wide around the turn, gave way in the drive. REATA'S ROCKET chased the leaders four wide around the turn and tired. GUNFIGHT off a step slowly, showed early foot along the rail, chased the leaders into the stretch and faltered. STORM TRUST raced with the pace three wide into the turn, then faded. FIRST CAVALRY was done early.
