Footnotes

YUKI allowed to settle after bumping with DIXIE COWBOY at the start, raced four wide around the far turn, eased inside DALAXY in the stretch, then rallied to be up in time. DIXIE COWBOY outrun after bumping with YUKI at the start, swung wide for the stretch run and closed well to be up for the place. ABET chased the pace, eased out and rallied to gain the lead at the sixteenth pole but couldn't resist the top ones in final strides. DALAXY reserved off the pace, raced four wide around the far turn and closed with a mild response to just miss the show. GARDEN TOUR set the pace under pressure along the rail to the sixteenth pole, then weakened late. BROKEANDBUSTED pressed the pace outside GARDEN TOUR to the sixteenth pole, then gave way. REY OF THE ROAD rated off the pace, lacked a late response. RAEALYN'S FRIEND unhurried early, rallied into contention in the stretch, then steadied in traffic and failed

to recover. SIR PHILIP was racing close up when steadied along in behind the leader on the first turn, continued to stalk the pace into the stretch, then tired. STAR FLYER chased the pace three wide into the stretch, then faltered. RUNNIN BAYOU was not a factor. HOLD THAT CAMERA raced in contention five wide around the far turn and faded.
