Footnotes

CAT CAN DO , under snug rating early, swung six wide making a run into the lane, rallied under strong handling to take over inside the sixteenth pole and held sway. ARSENAL tracked inside, moved inside rivals to take over in mid stretch, came out impeding MORE IS BETTER a sixteenth out then stayed on gamely once headed. BEDARRA prompted the pace three wide, moved to engage mid turn, battled between foes nearing mid stretch and faded. GOLDEN PHOENIX tracked four wide and lacked the needed rally. MORE IS BETTER set a rated pace in the two path, dueled in upper stretch, clipped the heels of ARSENAL when that one came out near the sixteenth marker then faded. XPECTATION (NZ) moved between rivals five furlongs out, steadied briefly when in close a half mile from the wire, angled four wide nearing the quarter pole but failed to generate the needed run. Following a stewards' inquiry, ARSENAL was disqualified from second and placed fifth for causing interference near the sixteenth pole
