E B RYDER unhurried after breaking slowly, circled rivals four wide around the far turn to reach contention, then responded to pressure and rallied to be up late. BRICKS AND CLICKS set the pace along the rail, increased her advantage in midstretch but couldn't resist the winner late. INCLUDE THE AUSSIE reserved off the pace, angled to the inside on the far turn and finished willingly for the show. ZAZZ rank and checked entering the first turn, tracked the pace along the inside into the stretch, then gave way. GRAN SABANA outrun early, saved ground and passed tired rivals. STREET GIRL off slowly, was not a factor. RICH CHOCOLATE tracked the pace three wide to the top of the stretch, then tired. SEASONSOFTHEHEART was outrun. SUMMON THE RAIN chased the pace off the rail to nearing the stretch, then faltered. CINDY CATA showed early foot, raced three wide around the far turn and faded.
