**Footnotes**

WINTER'S FURY chased the pace off the rail, moved to take over at the top of the stretch, edged away from MASTER WESLEY late, then was all out to hold off RULE NUMBER SIX. The latter, stalked the pace, angled out for the stretch run and was gaining on the winner at the finish. MASTER WESLEY set the pace along the inside, responded when headed by WINTER'S FURY at the top of the stretch, then weakened late. SITUATIONAL ETHICS reserved off the pace, saved ground and closed with a belated rally along the rail to just miss the show. BUZZ THE DEPUTY moved up down the backstretch to chase the pace three wide to inside the eighth pole, then gave way. DUBAI WONDER rank under restraint in the early going, saved ground and closed with a mild rally. GALACTICO failed to menace. TOUCHED THE CLOUDS was not a factor. HURRY UP ALAN off slowly, raced three wide and never threatened. EXETER ROAD was outrun. CANDLES ON FRIDAY outrun around the first turn for the lead, chased the pace along the inside into the stretch, then tired.
