LOVEABLE MANDY vied for the lead outside ADDED TIME, then drew away through the stretch under a strong hand ride. ADDED TIME bumped PYRENEE at the start, vied for the lead along the inside into the stretch, then couldn't stay with the winner while holding the place. MANDALAY POINT reserved after being bumped and steadied at the start, raced three wide on the turn and closed with a mild response. MEADOW MYSTERY raced five wide around the turn and couldn't gain late. MIDNIGHT APPEAL failed to menace after being outrun early. LINDA'S LAST QUEEN showed early foot along the inside and gave way. COUNTESS DE TIEMPO showed speed three wide and tired. RACHEL'S GOLD raced in striking position four wide around the turn and faltered. SISTER ST. JOHN was outrun while saving ground. PYRENEE bumped into MANDALAY POINT at the start, chased the pace around the turn and faded.
