MUSICAL FLAIR stalked the pace, angled outside the leaders in the stretch, then rallied to be up in the final strides. HELLO PRINCE hit the gate at the start, showed speed along the inside, then was vying for the lead when he came out bumping INDIRECTLY A. P. inside the sixteenth pole and couldn't resist the winner. MARTINI MADNESS raced with the pace three wide, was vying for the lead when bumped hard by INDIRECTLY A. P. inside the sixteenth pole and weakened. SILVER MENACE rated off the pace, advanced three wide around the turn to reach contention but had no further response. DIEZ well placed racing along the rail, didn't do enough late. INDIRECTLY A. P. pressed the pace outside HELLO PRINCE to inside the sixteenth pole, then was checked when knocked into MARTINI MADNESS and gave way. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS INQUIRY AND A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF INDIRECTLY A. P. FOR INTERFERENCE INSIDE THE SIXTEENTH POLE, HELLO PRINCE WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED SIXTH.
