TOH'S GREY CAT rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn, rallied to gain the lead inside the eighth pole and was fully extended to prevail.

STAFF SARGEANT unhurried early, raced four wide around the far turn and closed well to be up for the place. FOLK SINGER stalked the pace, eased outside D'ORO DANCER leaving the far turn, rallied to gain a slim lead in the stretch but couldn't resist the top ones. WIRE CUTTER reserved racing along the rail, advanced to loom a threat in midstretch but didn't do enough late while finishing on even terms with ELEVEN FINAL FOURS. The latter, unhurried while saving ground, was rallying into contention when steadied in behind rivals in the stretch, then came through tight quarters and finished willingly to dead heat with WIRE CUTTER. AWESOME ATTACK allowed to settle, gained some ground without threatening. P. L. HENRY stalked the pace into the stretch and weakened. BUFFALO STORM outrun early, moved up four wide around the far turn but had no late response. ECLIPTICAL'S ELVIS set the pace along the inside into the stretch and tired. D'ORO DANCER pressed the pace outside ECLIPTICAL'S ELVIS into the stretch, then faltered. EL SPEEDO was not a factor. WAT was outrun.
