PAM ANN DANCER chased the pace three wide around the turn, took over at the top of the stretch, edged clear, then was all out to hold off SACAJAWEAH. The latter, unhurried early, angled five wide midway of the turn and finished willingly for the place. MATTIE KATE dueled for the lead outside SILK 'N GOLD and tired. SILK 'N GOLD dueled for the lead, moved to the rail entering the turn but had nothing left for the stretch run. SUNMIST up close early, had no late response. JOEY'S SISTER faltered after showing early foot. ERICA'S DR. Z made a run at the leaders four wide on the turn and faded. FLOSSIE JO saved ground to no avail. GEM THIEF broke poorly, then trailed while racing wide.
