INDY CHARMER tracked the pace, angled outside the leaders leaving the turn, rallied to take over at the eighth pole and drew off under urging. NOMISTAKEABOUTIT prompted the pace outside HUGGINS, moved to gain a slim lead on the far turn, then was no match for the winner in the drive while continuing on with good courage to edge LAMBETH WALK for the place. The latter, steadied from tight quarters in the early going, rallied three wide on the far turn to reach even terms for command, vied with NOMISTAKEABOUTIT to midstretch, then couldn't stay with the winner while just missing the place. LAST CROWN outrun after hitting the gate at the start, failed to a menace. LIGHTLIVELY was not a factor. FLEET PAMPLONA chased the pace to the far turn and faltered. HUGGINS set the pace along the rail into the far turn, faded and was eased in the final eighth. FUNNY SKY rated off the pace, bolted leaving the far turn and was eased.
